Conflict minerals (CMRT) - Due diligence in the supply chain

Dear Sirs and Madams,

As a German company, we are subject to European legislation and thus possibly an EU regulation on the above-mentioned subject. After careful examination, we inform you that we are not affected by EU Regulation 2017/821 according to the criteria specified therein.


The ordinance lays down obligations for EU importers / Union importers for defined categories of commodities to meet the due diligence requirements in the procurement of tin, tantalum, tungsten, their ores and gold from conflict and high-risk areas.

LTN uses some of these substances and minerals to a limited extent. LTN procures the raw materials exclusively within the EU and is therefore not a Union importer. Consequently, LTN is not affected by the regulation from this point of view. In addition, LTN's annual quantities per raw material are currently well below the EU-defined quantity thresholds for imports.

Nevertheless, we asked our suppliers, who are located within the EU, about the topic. It has been proven in writing that the issue of "conflict minerals" is being dealt with responsibly. The quantities procured for each raw material are recorded annually and the relevant suppliers are checked annually. We have installed a repeatedly audited quality-und environmental management system in which regular supplier audits are an integral part.

We welcome and support Regulation (EU) 2017/821 on the introduction of due diligence obligations for Union importers as the EU's contribution to the stabilization of conflict and high-risk areas. The EU legislation and the resulting statutory duties of care are hereby fully respected.
